- 2. Treasurer Report Betzy McCarty We are at a net income of \$4,000. Finances will be posted on the website by the end of month. Income so far is bagel friday, company donation match, harvest moon, savings account, grocery store, IN, general fund, misc income, PTO thrift shop, restaurant night, and scholastic book fair. We've paid nearly \$9,000 in grants. \$3,300 in field trips and \$1,000 in enrichment. Note to teachers: all reimbursements requested by Monday 3/3 were processed and checks have been sent. Anything after 3/3 will be processed soon! Last day to submit reimbursement is June 2nd.
- 3. Principal Report Mrs. Clinkscale Thank you to bookfair! The cardboard cut-outs were a huge hit this time!! Thank you to bagel friday chairs as well We are partnering with the Ann Arbor rotary club for a food drive. We are collecting non-perishable food items. There will be a box in front of school; All items due Friday 3/21. Today starts registration for spring after school classes through rec and ed. Spots fill up fast, so sign up soon. DAW workshop is Monday 3/17 and we are still in need of volunteers. King Academic Games team was very successful- will be detailed in dreamkeeper on Friday 3/14. She is very grateful for highschool students to come and support our elementary students. There has been a change in date for report cards: moved from before spring break to after spring break. They will be released on Tuesday April 1. No winter NWEA scores will be sent home. They only send home fall and spring. The winter testing is intended to support teachers in the classroom.
